Mature Faith

Can you learn how to play the guitar? Can you learn how to play a sport? Everyone can learn how to do something, but just learning how to do something or obtaining a certain skill doesn't mean you've perfected it. You don't just learn how to shoot a basketball and expect to make the shot every time.
