# Weekly Devotional Thoughts | Terry Coomer

WHAT DOES A CHRISTIAN LOOK LIKE?

This is week 9 in our series. Over the past few week we looked at LOVE, OBEDIENCE, PRAYER, A SERVENT HEART, FORGIVING, WORKER, COMPASSION, and SPRITUAL GROWTH as a few CHARACTERISTICS that a Christian should exhibit. This week let's look at:

#### **SHARING THE GOSPEL**

As a Christian it should be a natural progression as we mature to want to spread the good news of the Gospel with others. Jesus said in Matthew 28:19-20 (ASV): 19 Go ye therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: 20 teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.

We read in the following passages that we have been given this responsibility in 2 Corinthians 5:18-21 (ESV): 18 All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, **and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation**. 20 Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. 21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

It is our duty to share this good news with others. We read In Romans 1:16 (ESV): 16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, **for it is the power of God for salvation** to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Are you willing to share Jesus with others?
