What does the Bible say about: WORKS AND ITS RELATIONSHIP TO SALVATION (PART 1)

There are a lot of teachers, preachers, and so-called bible scholars in the religious community that say "works" have no part in our salvation. Let's look and see what Scripture has to say.

We read in **Galatians 6:10** So then, as we have opportunity, **let us do good to all people**, especially to those who belong to the household of faith. — Ask yourself this question, is "doing good to all people" a work? Will it play a role in our salvation?

Let's look at what Jesus has to say about <u>doing good to others</u>. **Matthew 25:44 (ASV)** Then shall they also answer, saying, Lord, when saw we thee hungry, or a thirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? **Matthew 25:45 (ASV)** Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, inasmuch as ye did it not unto one of these least, ye did it not unto me. — According to the next verse Jesus equates failure to help others with eternal punishment. Those that did not help his fellow man are compared to not helping or tending to the needs of our Lord himself. **Matthew 25:46 (ASV)** And these shall go away into eternal punishment: but the righteous into eternal life.

Who are the righteous that will receive eternal life **Matthew 25:40 (ASV)** And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, inasmuch as ye did it unto one of these my brethren, even these least, ye did it unto me.

Good works are more than just a suggestion read **1 Corinthians 15:58 (ASV)** Wherefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmovable, **always abounding in the work of the Lord**, forasmuch as ye know that **your labor is not vain in the Lord**.

Let me clearly state that we cannot work or earn our way into Heaven, but as Christians we must produce fruit. **Jas 2:20** (KJV) But wilt thou know, O vain man, **that faith without works is dead? Jas 2:24 (KJV) Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only**.
