What does the Bible say about:

WORKS AND ITS RELATIONSHIP TO SALVATION (part 2)

As we continue to look at the role of works in relation to our salvation, let's take a look at how God has always required a response from us. Some teach that we have no part in our salvation. Is that really what the bible teaches?

No doubt God has His part, because of his love for us He sent His Son read John 3:16 (KJV) For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. John 3:17 (KJV) For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. —

The question is, do we play a part in our salvation? Mat 19:16 (KJV) And behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? Mat 19:17 (KJV) And he said unto him, why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, **keep the commandments**. — Jesus says to keep his commandments to have eternal life. What must I do “keep his commandments.

Noah was a good man, but that did not save him. Because of God's grace Noah was saved. God gave him a plan to follow, he told him exactly what to do. That was God's part. Noah believed God enough to obey him. Yes, Noah had a part. 1Pe 3:20 (KJV) Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. 1Pe 3:21 (KJV) **The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us** (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

The truth is Salvation is faith based and works based. God has always demanded obedience from us. God has given us a plan. He has told us exactly what to do. Because of Noah's faith he obeyed God and built the ark. He did exactly what he was told to do. **Do we believe God enough to follow his commands?**
