## Weekly Devotional Thoughts | Terry Coomer

**What does the Bible say about:**  
**THE LORD'S SUPPER (part 1)**

What is the purpose of it? Is it our responsibility to observe it? Was it a command or suggestion?

As humans it is very easy to forget, we go about our daily lives and over time we forget to remember, to give thanks, to pray, or even forget how we got to where we are.

You can see this over and over in the old Testament. God's people would follow God and prosper. Then they would forget and fall, even to the point that God allowed them to be taken into captivity.

God wants us to remember the great and perfect sacrifice of his Son Jesus. To help us remember he set up a memorial called the Lord's Supper. He told us when to observe it and how.

It is our responsibility to never get in the habit of just "going through the motions." When we do things repetitively that can be a danger. So, instead of going through the motions, go through the emotions. Remember what Jesus did for us. Remember the suffering and pain he was willing to go through for us.

**1Co 11:23 (ESV)** For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, **24** and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "**This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.**" **25** In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "**This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.**" **26** For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

We should not take this responsibility lightly **1Co 11:28 (ESV)** Let a person examine himself, then, and so eat of the bread and drink of the cup---
